

**Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands
Statewide Longitudinal Data System
Data Destruction Assurance Form**

Individuals conducting research on behalf of the CNMI Statewide Longitudinal Data System (SLDS) are required to destroy the target data that have been loaned to them during the duration of the project under the conditions of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the SLDS and **[Regesting Agency]**. This includes all copies, whether electronic or paper. These data must be destroyed when the research described in the MOA concludes, or the MOA terminates, whichever occurs first. In addition, the researcher(s) must provide copies of all reports associated with the research project to the CNMI SLDS within the time period specified in the MOA. As an assurance that these tasks have been completed, the project's principal investigator must complete this Data Destruction Assurance Form and submit it to the CNMI SLDS to be archived.
